XI. Old Business: A. Passage of Revision of the "Regulation of the Trumbull County Combined Health District for Establishing Fees" .08 Recreation – B. Pools – 2nd Reading

XII. New Business: A. Variance Request – Daniel & Susan Tietz, 3982 St. Rt. 305, Southington Twp. – Mrs. Tietz was present at the meeting. A real estate evaluation was conducted on October 5, 2015, and at the time of the inspection it was revealed that a hand dug well and cistern were present. A notice to seal the existing hand dug well was issued. The owner contacted the health department and requested that they not be required to seal the old hand dug well. The owners purchased the property based upon the potential for restoration of the circa 1837 I-house that is located on the property. Mr.

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& Mrs. Tietz have requested a variance to allow them to keep the hand dug well and cistern for historical reasons. Mr. Wilster stated that ODH has no opinion regarding the granting of this variance, and that his only objection is setting a precedence wherein anyone would request a variance stating it was for historic reasons. Mrs. Tietz, who is a Survey & National Register Manager for the Ohio Historical Society, presented evidence substantiating her request to keep the hand dug well and cistern to preserve the historical nature of the property. Mr. Messersmith questioned as to whether Mrs. Tietz planned on using the dug well or cistern for human consumption; Mrs. Tietz stated that they were not.

MOTION: 17-10 made by Mr. Messersmith, second by Dr. Agana to grant a variance to Daniel & Susan Tietz to not require the hand dug well and cistern to be sealed for historical reasons, based upon the documentation supplied by the property owner.

Mr. Dubos questioned as to whether this type of variance had ever been granted previously. Mr. Wilster stated that to his knowledge, no. Mr. Migliozzi added that variances such as these would be handled on a case-by-case basis.

B. Variance Request – Joseph & Trudy Pavlic, 6578 St. Rt. 87, Kinsman Twp. – Not present. Mr. & Mrs. Pavlic installed a new on-lot septic system in 2006. In March of 2016, our office was notified by the Trumbull County Sanitary Engineer's office that this property was benefited by sewers, through the Kinsman Phase 2 Sanitary Sewer Project, and a notice to connect was issued to the owners. The property owners submitted a request for a variance from connecting to the available sanitary sewer. An inspection of the septic system was conducted, and upon inspection, it was found that there existed a septic system that consisted of two-1,000 gallon tanks, 500 feet of leach field with a splitter box. A dye test was conducted, and the system was found to be acceptable on a performance basis.

MOTION: 17-11 made by Mr. Messersmith, second by Dr. Agana, to grant a variance to Joseph & Trudy Pavlic from the orders to connect to the available sanitary sewer, for the property located at 6578 St. Rt. 87, Kinsman Twp., for a period of five (5) years. The homeowner must re-apply for a variance every five (5) years to continue the variance, or must connect to the sanitary sewers.

C. Declaration of Unfit for Human Habitation – RECISSION – 27 W. Liberty St., City of Newton Falls, Alberto Talanca, Owner – Mr. Talanca was present at the meeting. At the October 26, 2016, Board of Health meeting, the Board voted to declare this structure unfit for human habitation. According to the policy, the occupant of the house was cooking meth in the garage, which posed a significant fire and chemical poisoning exposure hazard to the individuals in the home. The health district was called in by the Trumbull County Sheriff's Department to conduct an inspection of the structure. Since that time, the owner has made several repairs to the structure. Mr. Talanca has removed all of the carpeting, removed the kitchen flooring and any wood flooring was stripped and repainted. The kitchen and upstairs walls were removed and new drywall was installed, and the downstairs walls have been cleaned and repainted. Newton Falls City Officials are satisfied with the evidence presented showing that the conditions that were present at the time of the health department's inspection have been corrected, and requested that the declaration of unfit be rescinded, and the environmental health staff concurs with the city's findings. Mr. Francis stated that Mr. Talanca went above and beyond cleaning and making the necessary repairs to the structure.

Upon inspection, the inspector, Rod Hedge, noted water damage and that the ceiling in the rear of the building was in collapse due to the heavy water damage.
