- IV. Health Commissioner Report:** Mr. Migliozi presented a written report to the Board for their review. Mr. Migliozi informed the Board that Dr. Firster had called him and indicated that he had an emergency, and would be unable to attend today's meeting. Mr. Wilster also asked that he be excused from today's meeting, but did provide an update on several issues. Bell Wick Bowl is closed and the closure has been verified. The health inspector has made two visits to Reform Fitness, and they are in full compliance. The health district will continue to monitor the situation. Mosquito surveillance will begin tomorrow. We received additional traps to increase surveillance, and the surveillance is being offered county wide.

The hepatitis A numbers continue to rise. Currently there are 2,600 cases, in 76 counties, 61% of those have been hospitalized, with eight deaths. The Ohio Department of Health has distributed 53,000 doses of vaccine to Ohio's local health districts. The Community Health Assessment release is scheduled for June 6, 2019, and all board members are welcome to attend. We are trying to get a community response to this release, so flyers were sent to local churches and the media. At the recent Health Commissioner's conference, it was stated that a House Bill had been passed to allow local health districts to obtain credit cards. We will be looking into this, and bring a policy back to the next Board meeting.





## Health Commissioner's Report – May 22, 2019 Board of Health Meeting

### 1) Budget/Financial

- Attached is the monthly financial report for April. The general fund shows a positive cash balance of \$579,371.50, with our all fund balance at \$1,858,992.00.

### 2) Time Study

- Attached is my time study for the month of April. The bulk of my time was spent on administrative issues, accreditation and household sewage treatment system program.

### 3) Vehicles

- Attached is the cost analysis for the month of April for the vehicles. The overall cost savings with the vehicles, for the month of April, was \$2,629.44, with a year to date savings of \$6,794.70.
- You will notice that the cost savings has increased significantly over the last month. The Chevy Blazer is being used more now, and there was also an increased use of the Fusion.

### 4) Hepatitis A Outbreak (As of 4/29/19)

- There have been 2,178 cases, and the outbreak is now in 76 counties in Ohio.
- 61% of those cases have been hospitalized, and there have been seven deaths.
- There have been 49,690 doses of vaccine distributed to local health departments.

### 5) Measles Outbreak

- There still have been no reported cases of measles in Ohio.
- ODH is working on a FAQ document regarding measles vaccinations. It has been questioned as to whether people who got vaccinated between 1963-1968 with the kills measles need to be revaccinated. ODH advises that they speak with their physician.

### 6) Basement

- The basement clean-up project continues to move forward, and Johnna and Dan continue to go through all the old equipment in the basement and listing items on GovDeals, which is the internet auction site that the county uses to get rid of old equipment.
- I spoke with Mike Sliwinski of the Building Department, and he is working with a consultant to draft the bid specifications and proposal for the basement renovations.
- We also shredded 3,849 pounds of old documents that were being stored in the basement.

### 7) Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA)

- The CHNA rough draft release occurred on April 29, 2019.
- The full public release will occur on June 6, 2019, 8:30 AM, at Kent State University Trumbull Branch, in the classroom building auditorium, and it should last approximately 4 hours. All Board Members are welcome to attend.

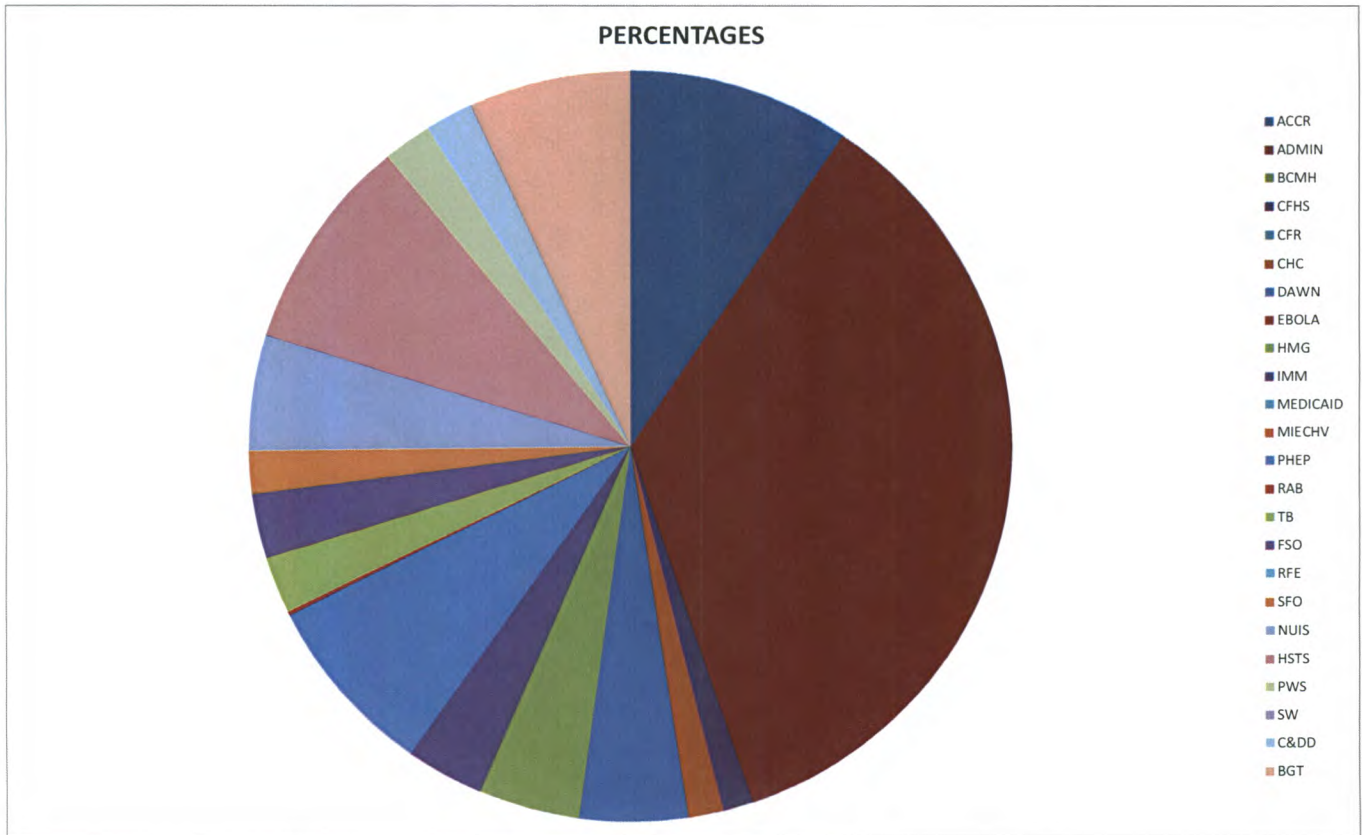

## Trumbull County Combined Health District Nursing Department Board Report

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### **Board of Health Report May 22, 2019 for April 2019**

- As of May 6, 2019, Trumbull County (TCCHD and Warren City jurisdictions) continues to have 15 Hepatitis A cases linked to the multi-state Hepatitis A outbreak. Typically Trumbull County has less than 1 case a year. TCCHD has been reaching out to high risk groups to provide Hepatitis A vaccine. Many of these groups are within the Warren City Health jurisdiction and that health district has been providing vaccine to these high risk groups. TCCHD will continue to do outreach to provide vaccination. Ohio cases as of May 6, 2019: 2,210 cases with 7 deaths. Outbreak cases are in 76 of the 88 counties.
- The Nursing Divisions of TCCHD and Warren City Health District (WCHD) facilitated the 4<sup>th</sup> annual Kent State University Trumbull Campus (KSU-TC) POD (Point of Dispensing) drill on April 30, 2019. This collaboration with KSU-TC provides TCCHD and WCHD with the opportunity to practice a potential real life scenario on a smaller scale, as well as provides the KSU-TC Nursing students the opportunity to experience a plausible event for their Community Health class.
- On April 14, 2019, Kathy Parrilla was awarded the 2019 Sigma Theta Tau, Xi Xi Chapter Award for Excellence in Community Service at Youngstown State University. Kathy was nominated by Purity Kimani, who is one of the Eastern Ohio Area Health Education Center (EOAHEC) Scholars that came to DAWN training. Kathy sits on the EOAHC Board of Health Directors and works with these scholars. The Award for Excellence is awarded to those people who demonstrate a leadership role in encouraging the use and promotion of professional standards through appointment or election to local and regional task forces, commissions, councils, or committees.

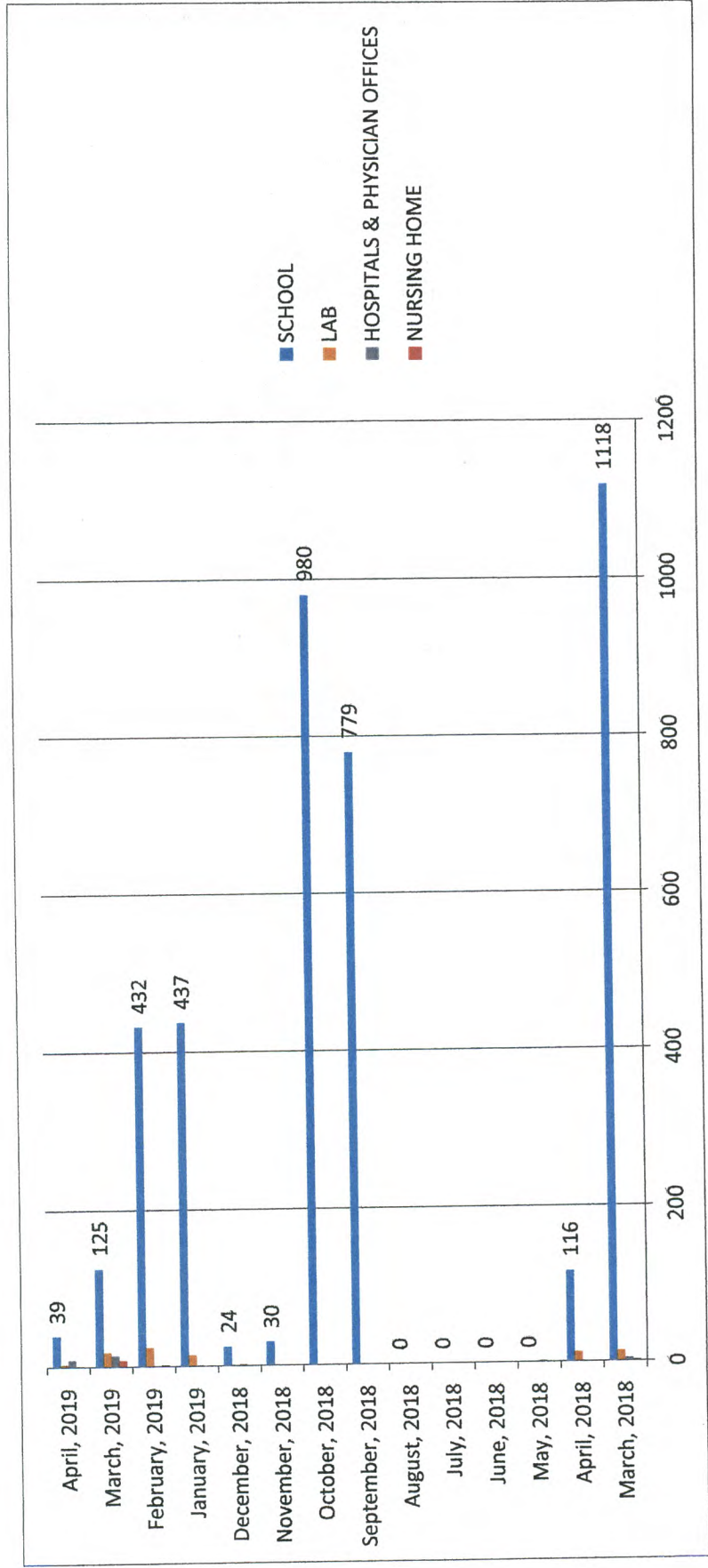

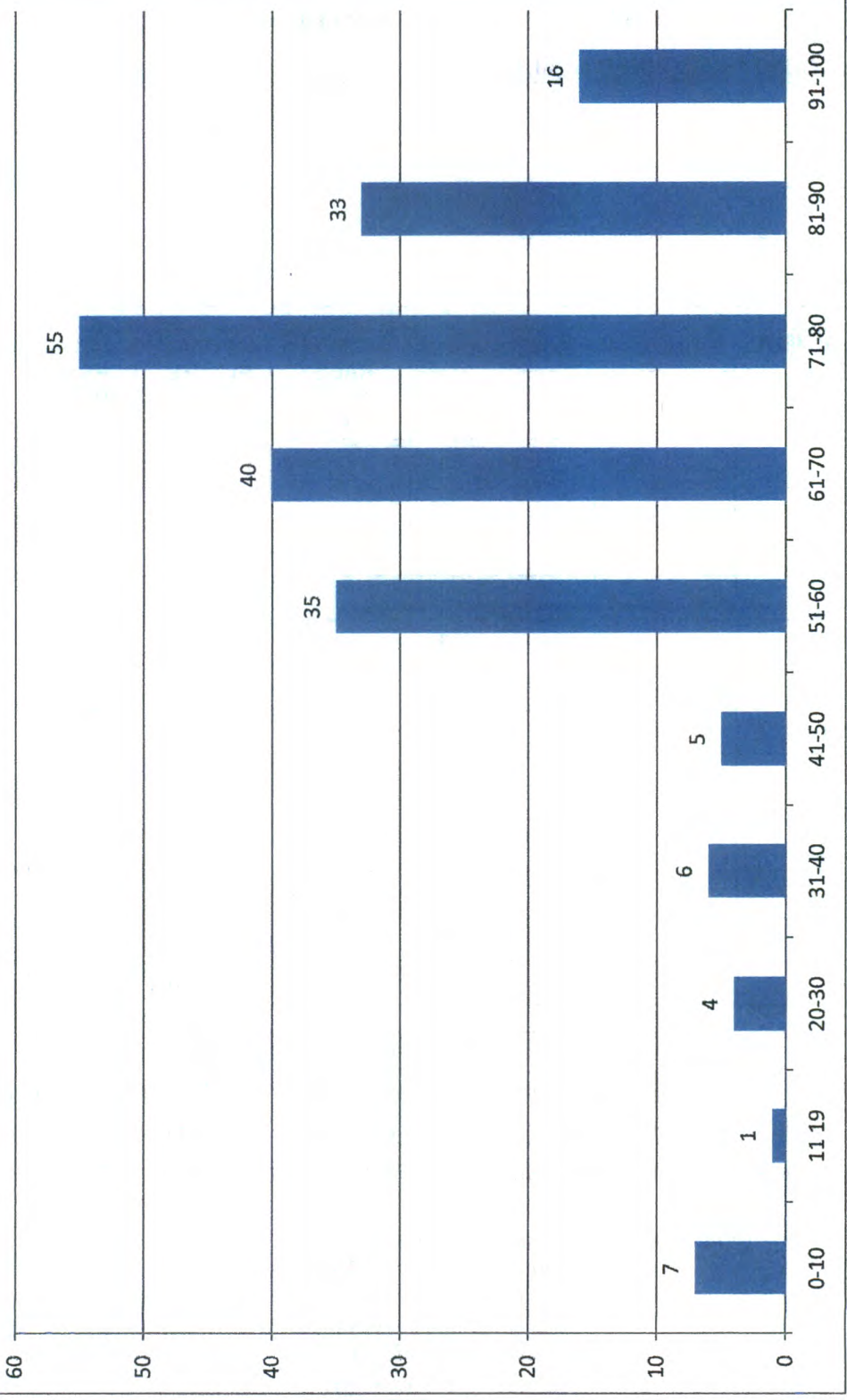

We continue to see an uptick in the numbers of overdoses and overdose deaths that are occurring in Trumbull County. We continue to see Cocaine laced with Fentanyl as well as increase in the methamphetamine use in the county. In 2018, from Jan.1<sup>st</sup> through 4/23 we had a total of 16 overdose deaths and in 2019 from Jan.1<sup>st</sup> through 3/13 we have had 27 overdose deaths. Looking ahead we are hoping we see a decline in these numbers in the very near future.

Figure 1. A monthly count of emergency departments visits due to overdoses in Trumbull County by Zip Codes. There were 35 overdoses during the month of April.

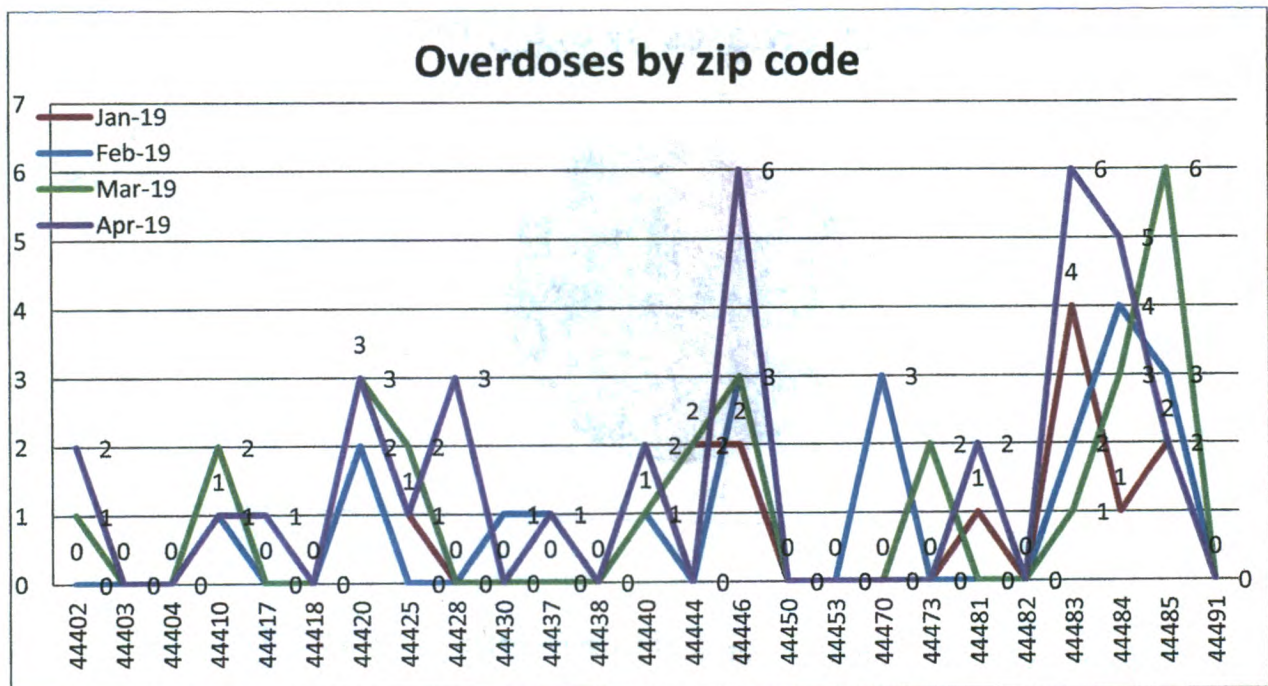


Figure 2. Gender distribution of overdose-related ED visits; Trumbull County; April 2019

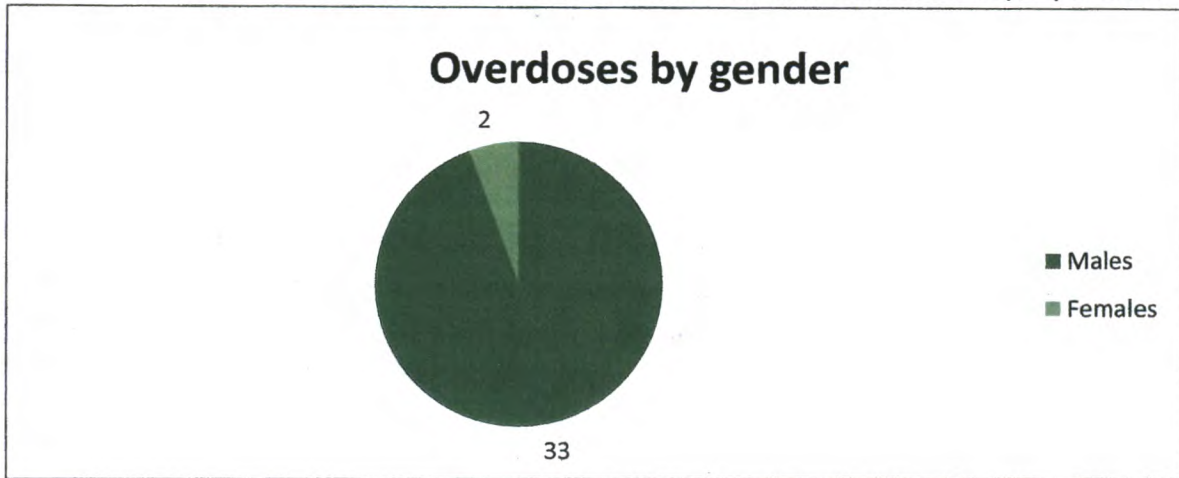
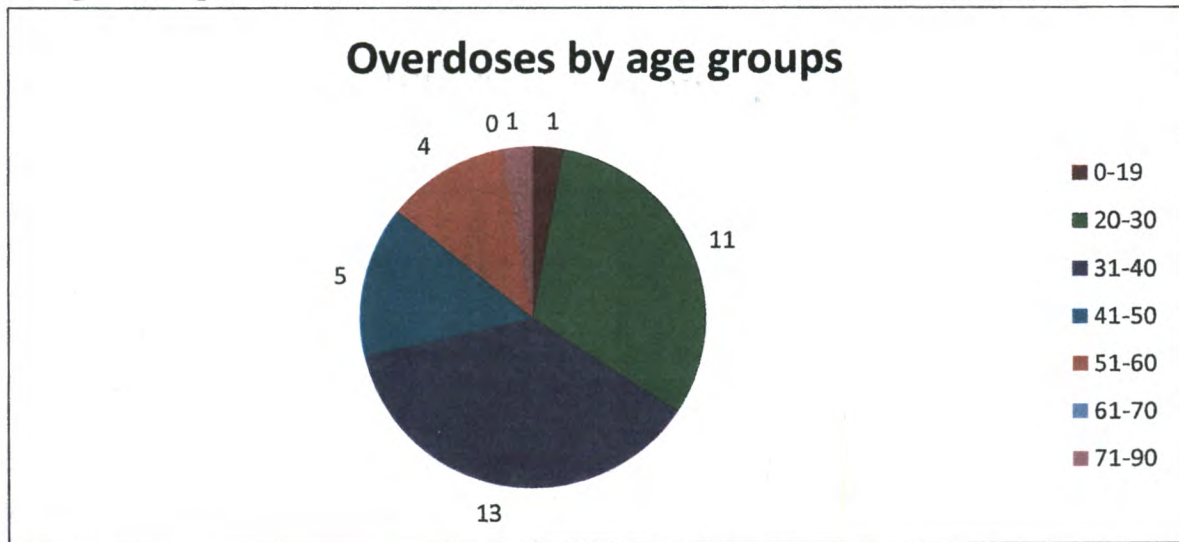


Figure 3. Age distribution of overdose related ED visits; Trumbull County; April 2019

Figure 4. The days of the week that the overdoses occurred in Trumbull County; April 2019.

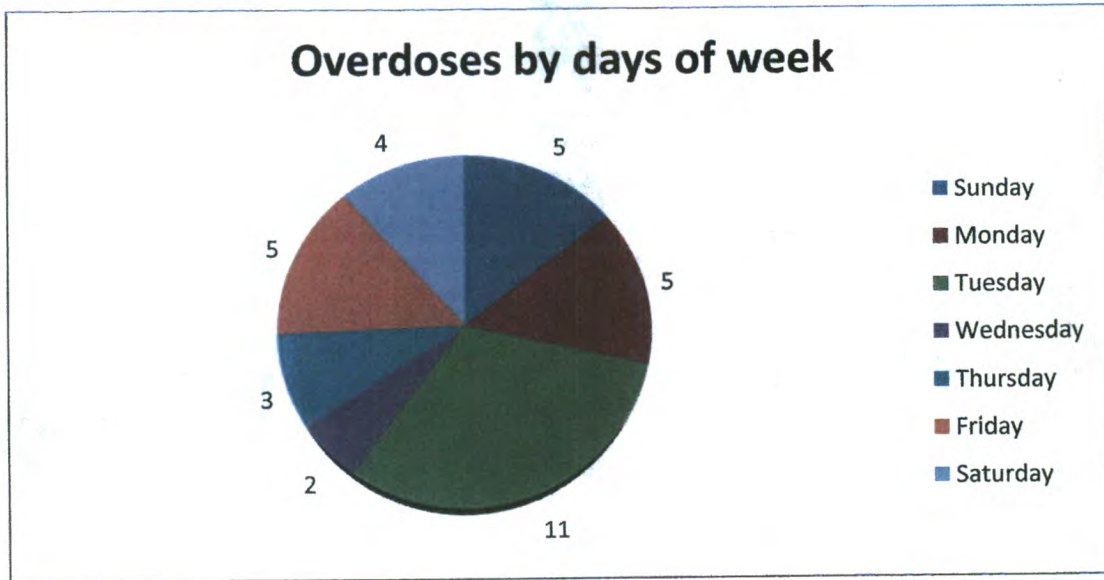
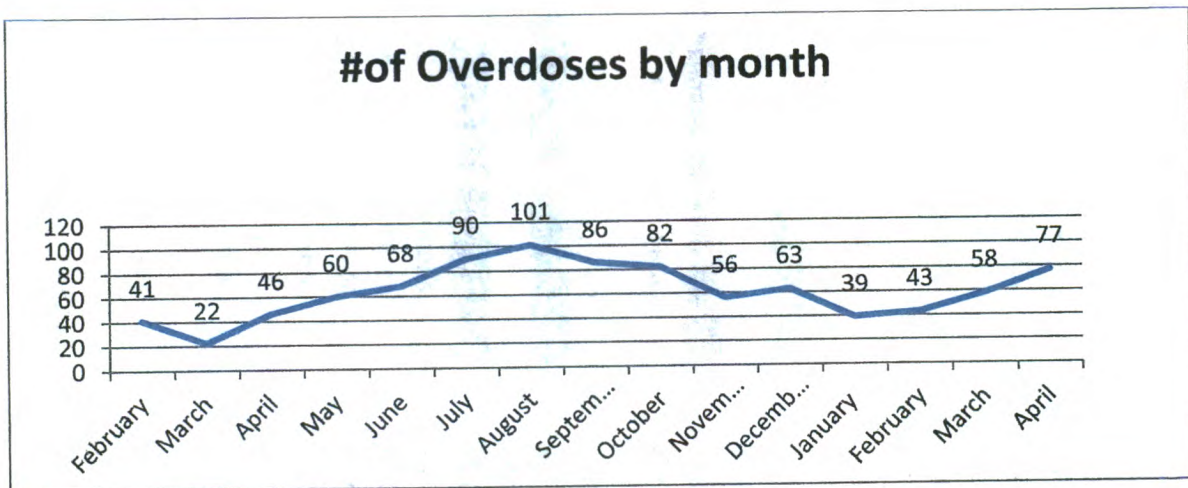


Figure 5. Chart of total overdoses from January 2018- March 2019

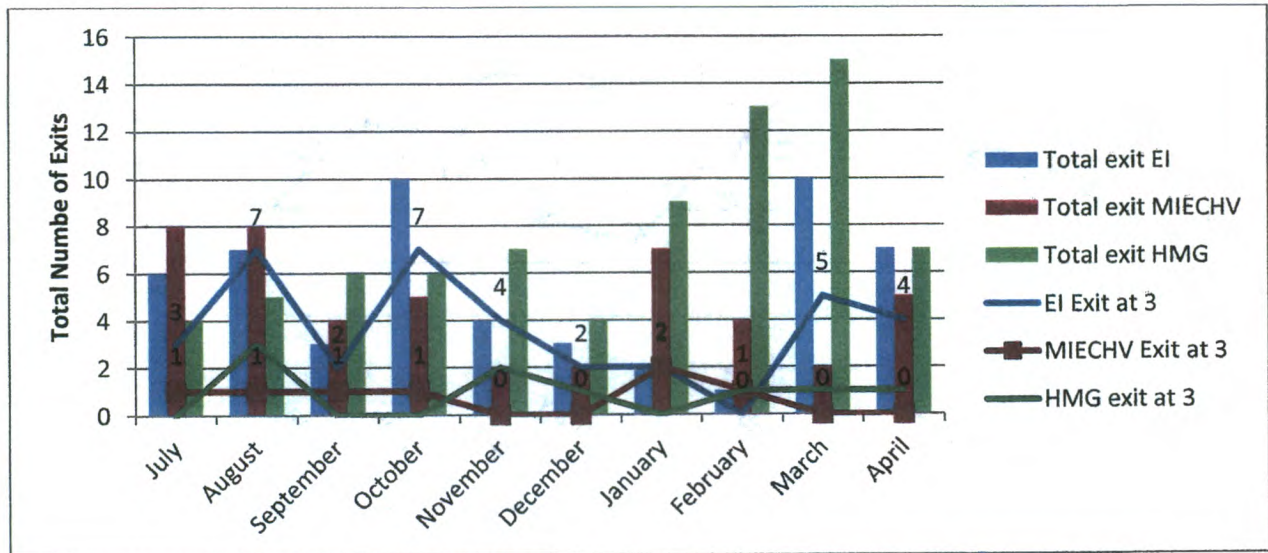

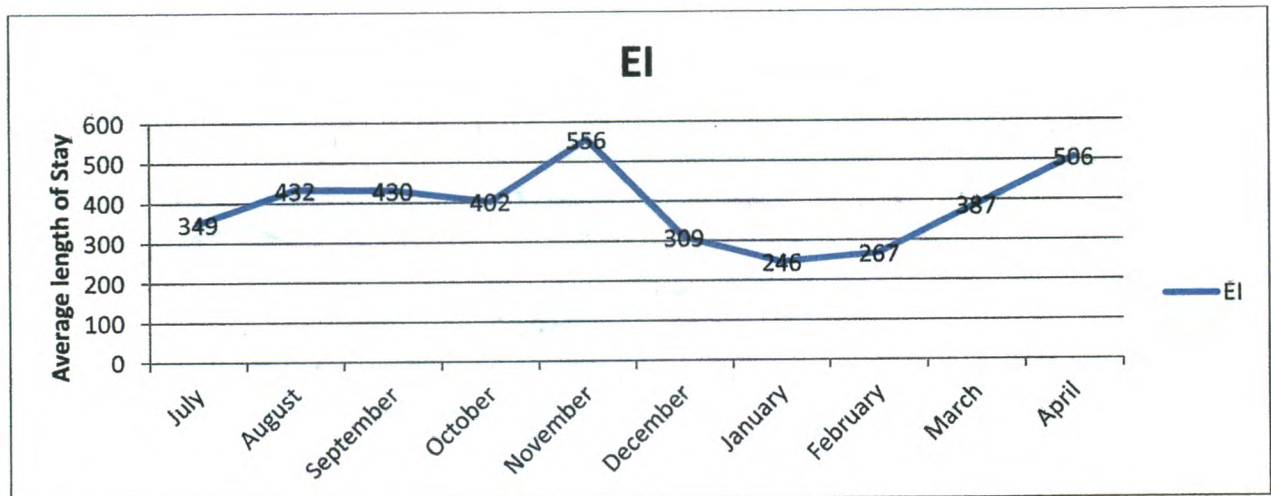

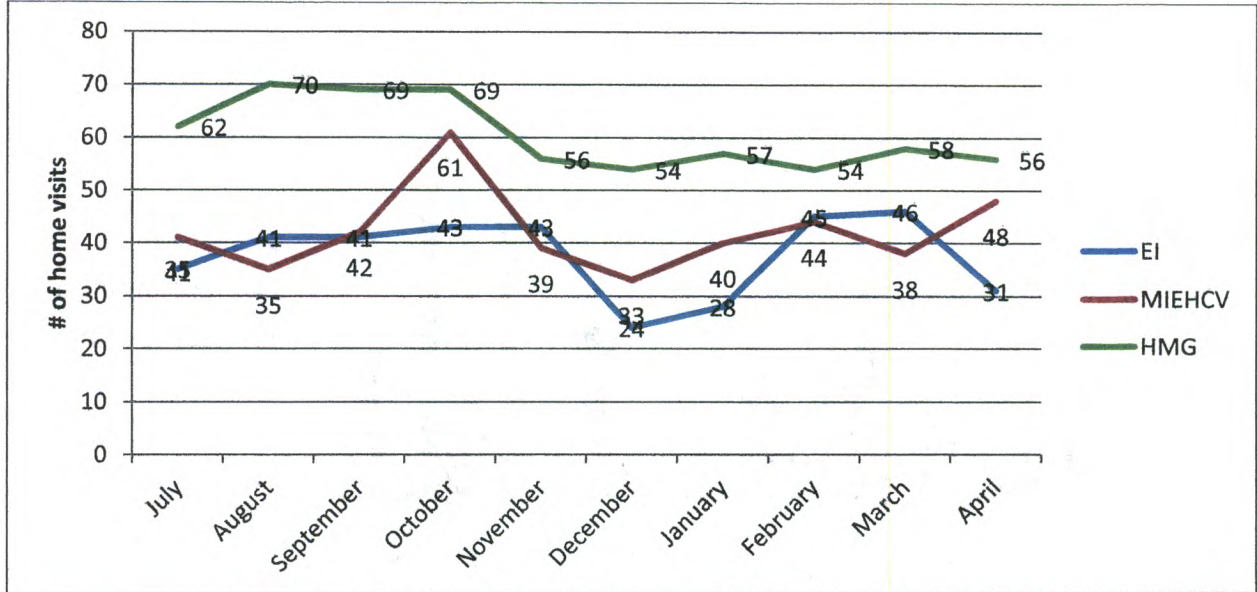
### Total # of exits



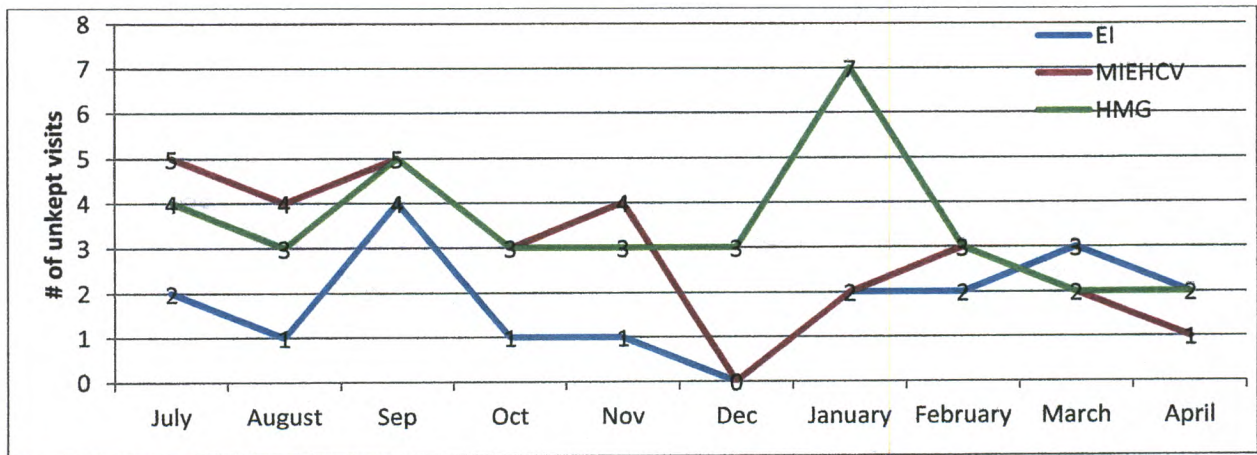

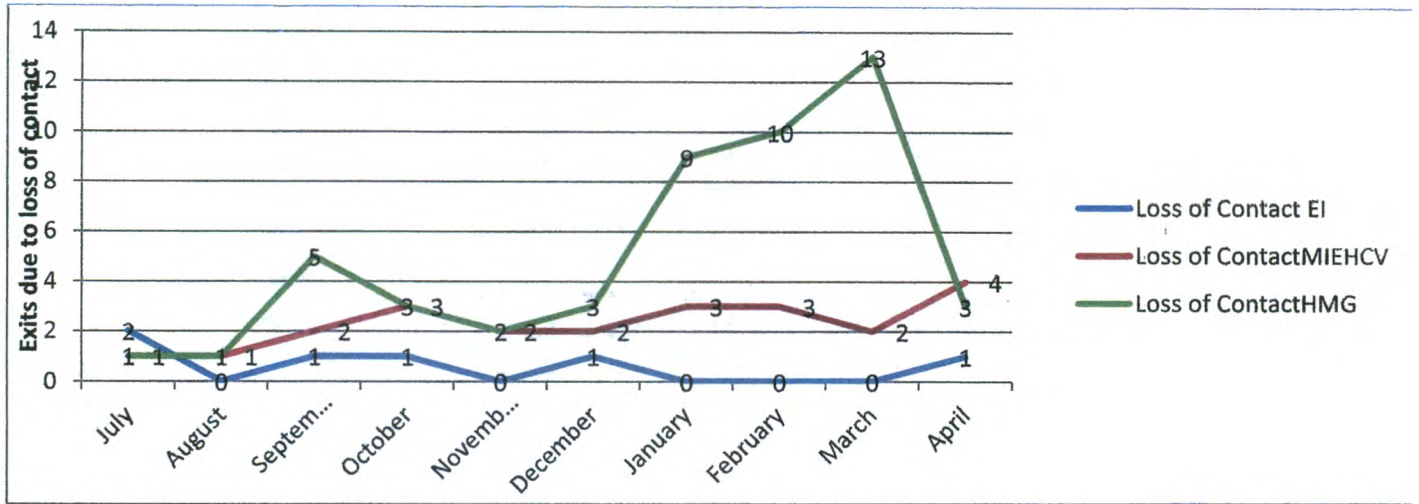

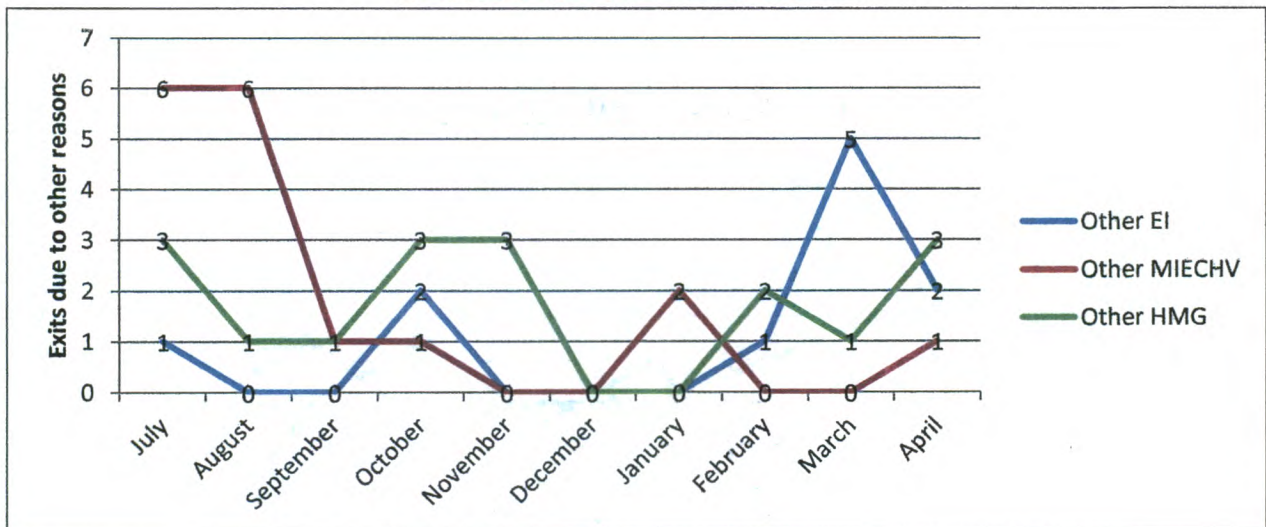

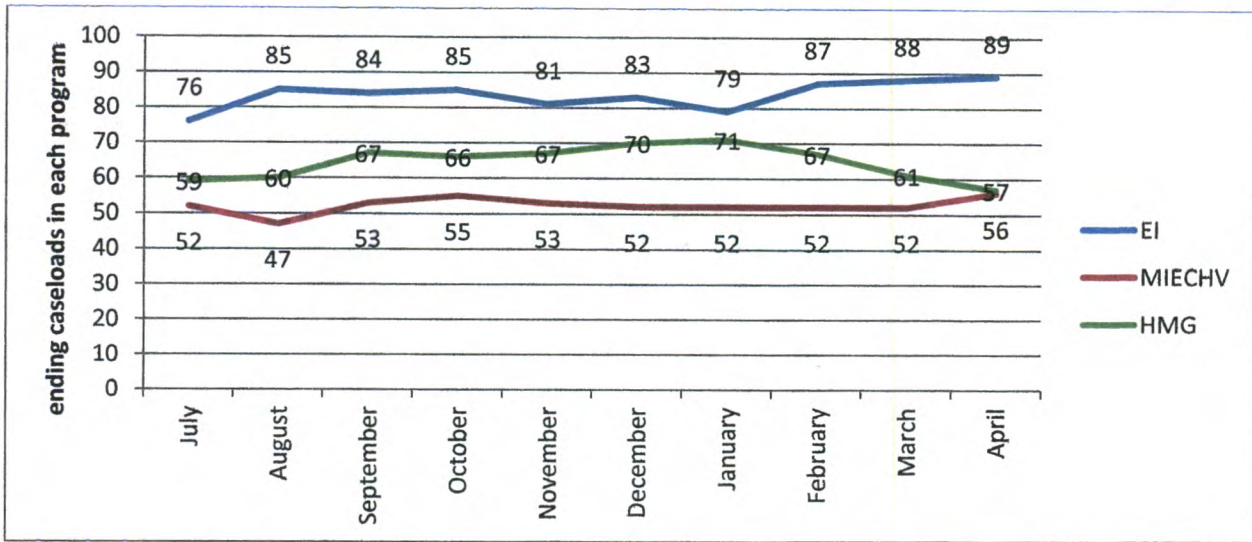

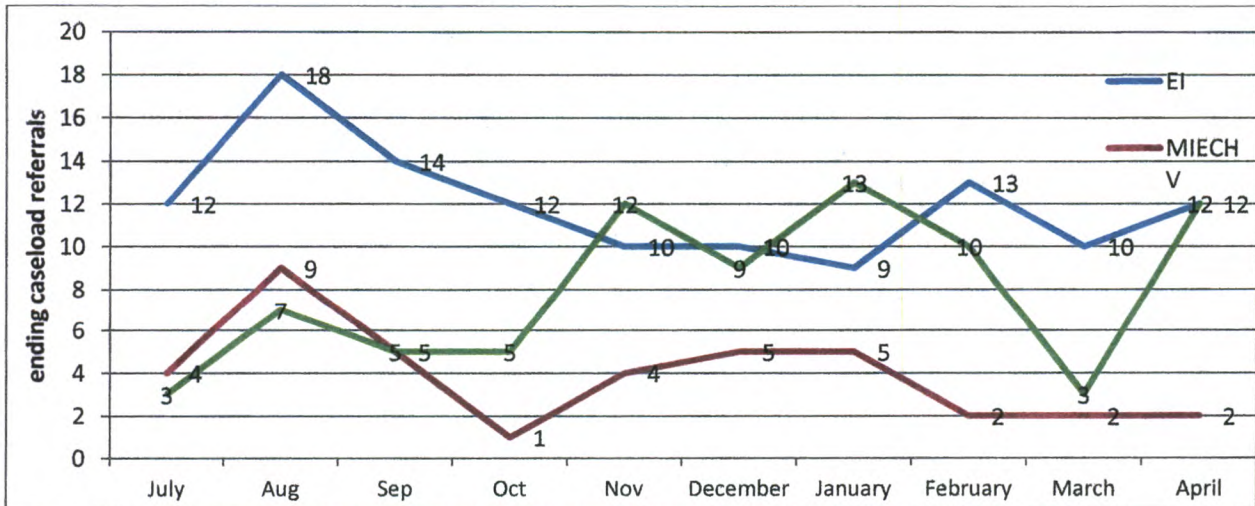
