CAR SEAT SAFETY GUIDELINES

What is the safest car seat for your child?

It is the one that:

1. FITS YOUR CHILD

Make sure you child's height and weight fall within the car seats limits. It is on the label and in the book.

2. FITS YOUR VEHICLE

Make sure the car seat fits in the back seat of your car before using it.

3. EASY TO USE CORRECTLY EACH TIME

The easier it is the more likely it will be used correctly each and every time.

CAR SEAT SAFETY CLASSES INCLUDE:

- *Ohio Safety Laws
- *Video of the 4 steps to Child Passenger Safety
- *How to operate the parts of your seat.
- *Instruction for placing seat in your vehicle correctly by a certified Child Passenger Safety Technician.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- *Must have a child between ages of birth thru 3 years who **does not currently have a seat**
- *Car seats available at a low cost to parent/guardian only (Grandparents can attend classes for education)
- *One car seat per child
- *Must attend educational class to receive a car seat
- *New parents <u>must have car seat</u>

before going to the hospital

FOLLOW THE 4 STAGES OF CAR SEAT USE:

REAR: child should be rear facing closer to the age of 2 and to weight limit of seat

FORWARD: child should be forward facing until 4 years and 40 pounds

BOOSTER: child should use a booster seat between ages of 8-12 and to the height of 4'9"

SEAT BELTS: EVERYONE/EVERYTIME



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
