#### **Covid-19 Vaccine Clinics**

The TCCHD has been and continues to work diligently against the Covid-19 virus and Pandemic within Trumbull County. The TCCHD continues to hold Covid-19 vaccination clinics on a weekly basis at the Eastwood Mall on Tuesday’s and Thursday’s from 5:00pm to 7:00pm, and the first Saturday of every month from 10:00am to 12:00pm. All 3 vaccinations (Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson) are generally available. Covid-19 booster shots are also available!

#### **Covid-19 Testing**

Currently the TCCHD has a number of over the counter and home Covid-19 test kits. Anyone interested in receiving at home/over the counter test kits should reach out to the nursing division of the TCCHD at 330-675-2489. Meanwhile, if possible continue to mask, maintain safe distance from others, wash your hands, and get vaccinated. These measures will help protect you from COVID-19.

#### **Covid-19 Data**

##### **As of February 23, 2022:**

- The TCCHD has administered approximately 41,743 doses of the Covid-19 Vaccine.
- 20,803 are first doses,
- 17,739 are second doses,
- 3,201 are third/booster doses.
- The number of confirmed and probable Covid -19 cases has declined to less than 50 per day.

#### **TCCHD History**

On March 26, 1926, the BOH adopted a resolution supporting a plan outlined by the Farm Bureau regarding the eradication of bovine TB in dairy cattle.

On March 30, 1926, The board of health offices moved to the rooms 508 and 509 inside the Union Savings and Trust Bank which was located at the corner of E. Market and N. Park Ave.

1. U.S. residents are now able to order 4 at-home Covid-19 test kits per household. Please visit [www.COVIDtests.gov](http://www.COVIDtests.gov) to order right away. The test kits start to ship near the end of January. Currently, only one order of 4 is allowed per household. U.S. residents may also call 1-800-232-0233 for assistance with placing an order.
2. Ohio has seen a 90% drop in Covid-19 cases since January of 2022.
3. The CDC will be releasing new Covid-19 mask guidelines relatively soon.
