Covid-19 Vaccine Clinics

The TCCHD has been and continues to work diligently against the Covid-19 virus and Pandemic within Trumbull County. Throughout the month of July, the TCCHD will hold Covid-19 vaccination clinics throughout all of Trumbull County. Please contact the Nursing division of the TCCHD at 330-675-2489 for details about those clinics. All 3 vaccinations (Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson) are generally available. Covid-19 booster shots are also available!

Covid-19 Testing

Currently the TCCHD has a number of over the counter and home Covid-19 test kits. Anyone interested in receiving at home/over the counter test kits should reach out to the nursing division of the TCCHD at 330-675-2489. Meanwhile, if possible continue to mask, maintain safe distance from others, wash your hands, and get vaccinated. These measures will help protect you from COVID-19.

Covid-19 Data

As of June 22, 2022, for May 2022:

- The TCCHD has administered approximately **42,407** doses of the Covid-19 Vaccine.
- **20,871** are first doses,
- **17,786** are second doses,
- **3,373** are third/booster doses, and **377** are second booster doses,
- The TCCHD uses *the CDC Covid-19 Community Levels tool* to recommend what prevention steps to take. Levels can be **Low**, **Medium**, or **High**.
- Currently, Trumbull County, Ohio is **Medium**. **Prevention steps include:**
- **Staying up-to-date with Covid-19 vaccines, getting tested if you have symptoms, if you are at a high risk for severe illness, talk to your healthcare provider about whether or not to wear a mask and take other precautions.**
- Trumbull County currently has a case rate of **202** per 100,000, and a positivity rate of **11.6%**

Eye Safety for at Home and Outdoors.

Eye injuries affect about 2.5 million people every year, below are tips to prevent injury to your eye.

At home:

- *Wear chemical safety goggles when using hazardous chemicals. Don't mix cleaning agents,
- *Turn Nozzles away from your face when spraying,
- *Wash your hands after using household chemicals,
- *Use guards on all power equipment,
- *Wear protective eye gear while using a lawnmower and weed trimmer.

Outdoors:

- *Wear sunglasses to protect your eyes from UV light,
- *Never look directly at the sun,
- *Wear safety goggles during sports and leisure activities,
- *Wear a helmet with a polycarbonate face mask during high impact sports,
- *Wear safety goggles while using devices that fire projectiles (Pellets, Arrows, etc.),
- *Wear safety goggles when handling fireworks.

Mosquito Surveillance Going Strong Right Now!

The TCCHD is currently and actively conducting Mosquito Surveillance throughout the County! Mosquitos that are trapped are sent away for testing related to West Nile Virus and other communicable diseases they transmit. In addition to the surveillance, the TCCHD is also treating stagnant water areas to prevent mosquito larvae from maturing into adult mosquitos.
