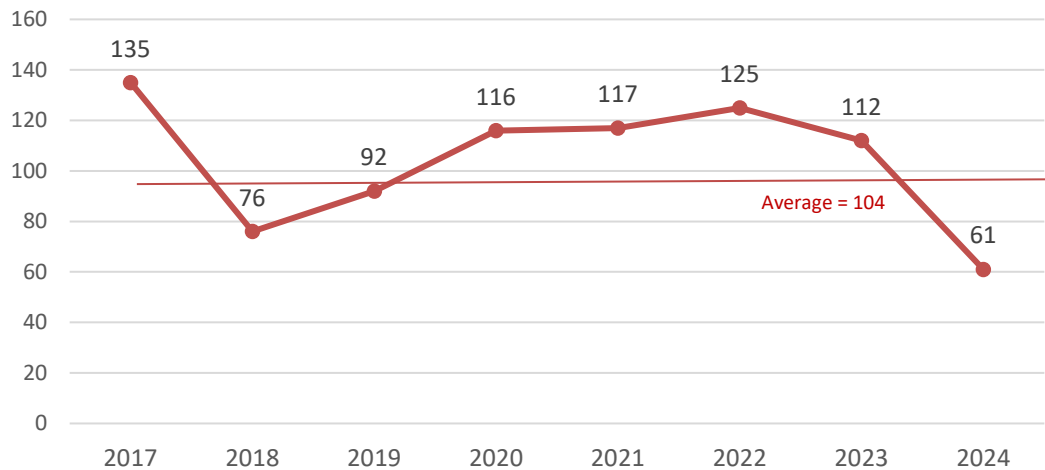

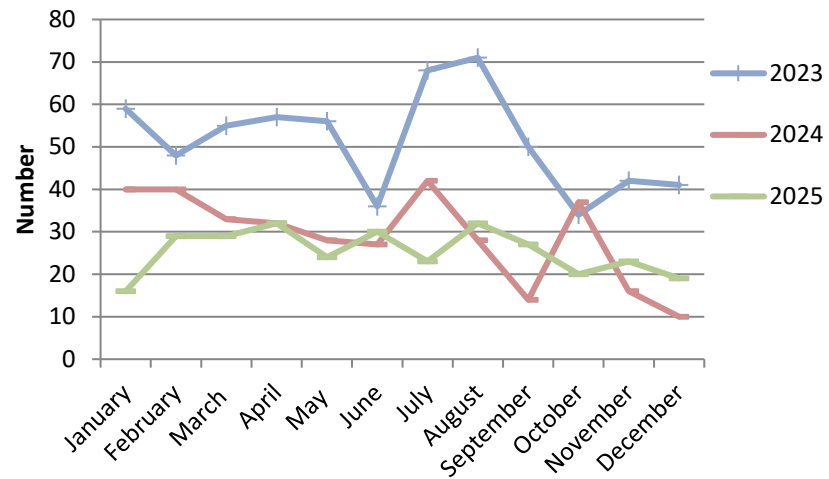
Accidental Drug Related Deaths: Trumbull County

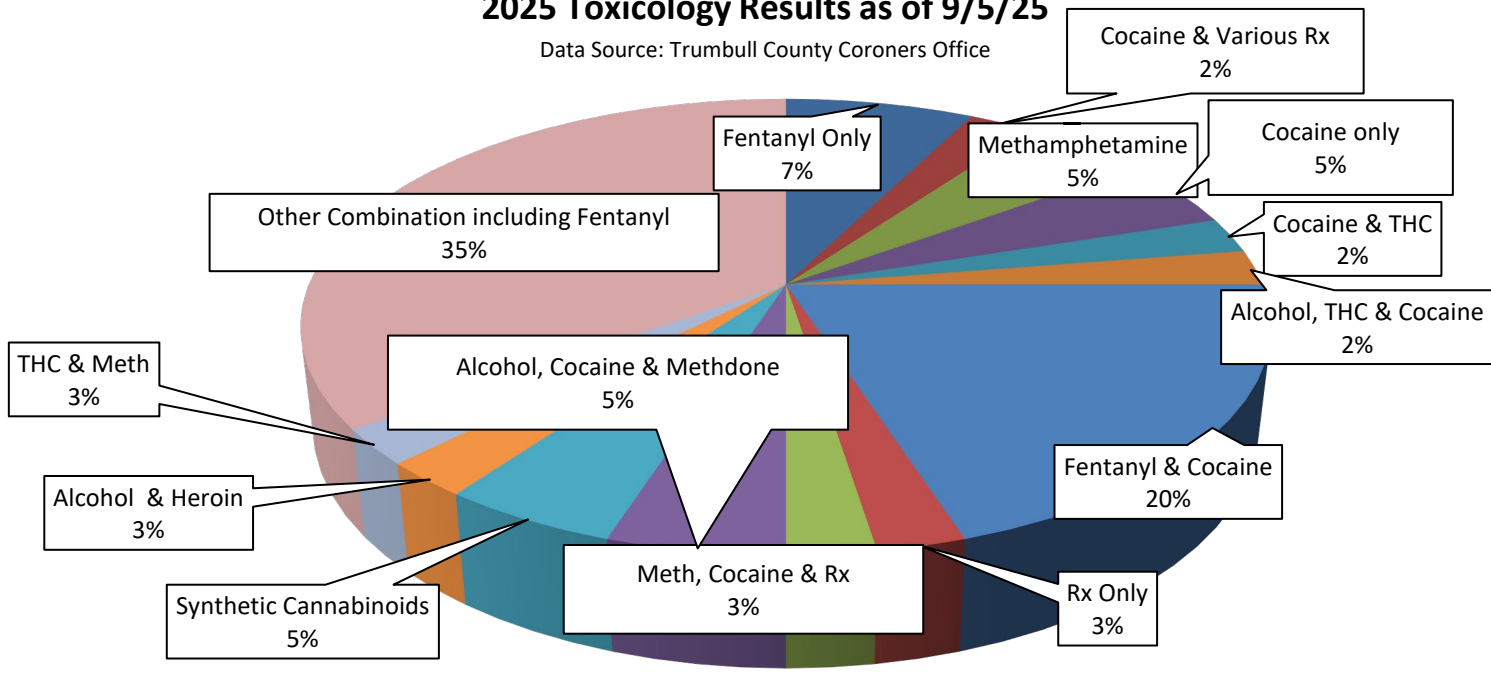
Overdoses by Month
